Abuse/Neglect Prevention & Reporting

This workshop provides an overview of Denver Options' Policy and Procedure 2.4, Mistreatment, Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation (MANE) reporting. It also touches on Policy and Procedure 2.3, Incident Reporting. The focus will be on how these policies are implemented by staff and managers working in the field.

All Things Considered

Participants in this comprehensive overview of issues facing persons with developmental disabilities will learn about the diagnosis of mental retardation, causes of developmental disabilities, the effects of brain damage, psychosocial/developmental issues, learning issues, and the significance of various mental disorders and their medication and psychological treatment using a case-study format.

Behavioral Intervention - Keeping it Positive

This training emphasizes a values-based approach to behavior assessment and intervention. Participants will learn how their behavior influences others and how changing their responses can assist in shaping and maintaining positive behavior in others. The importance of functional and environmental assessments is underscored and how to use these tools when developing individualized behavior supports is emphasized. The basic principals of behavior intervention will also be reviewed and discussed.

Do the Right Thing

This training is intended to provide an opportunity for individuals to explore their value system in relation to legal rights and the values of the people with whom we work. We'll take a look at how values are translated into employee behavior and actions, and how ethical principles are an integral part of the hundreds of decisions we make on a daily basis.

The Individualized Plan: Enhancing Lives for People in Services through Planning

This training is to familiarize people with the IP document, the processes involved in creating an IP, the expectations from service agency staff and the values of Denver Options and the IP team.

ISSP Training

This training will walk participants through the steps that are necessary to ensure effective Individualized Service and Support Plans are being identified, developed, implemented and monitored according to the individualized needs of our customers.

Legal Rights

This workshop focuses on a general overview of CRS 27-10.5, which is the Colorado law regarding the care and treatment of people with disabilities. The rights identified in this law are discussed, as well as some specific instances to watch for in which an individual's rights might be unknowingly violated. Confidentiality issues, informed consent and guardianship laws are also covered in this training.

Restrictive Procedures

The emphasis of this workshop is placed on making sure good functional assessments are completed in order to identify non-restrictive positive based supports that can and should be tried prior to the uses of restrictive procedures. Participants will learn what constitutes a restrictive procedure and the necessary steps that must be taken prior to implementation. Participants will also learn about the differences between safety controls, emergency controls, rights suspensions, and restrictive interventions.
